Day of Arrival - Arusha. You will be met at Kilimanjaro International airport in Tanzania and transferred to your booked hotel in Arusha. Dinner is on your own account. Stay overnight at your booked ([Hotel in Arusha](#)). (Bed & Breakfast)

Day 1. Arusha / Central Serengeti.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast in your booked [Hotel in Arusha](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – Depart from Arusha and head north-west to the game-rich Seronera Valley in central area of Serengeti National Park. If you are travelling from December to April, the annual wildebeest migration in Serengeti National Park is definitely an event that you cannot afford to miss. The lush plains of the Serengeti plains have made it an ideal home to wildlife for millions of years. This ancient ecosystem continues to thrive to date and wildebeests, zebras, gazelles and giraffes are often seen grazing in herds. This is one of the best places in the world to spot lions dozing in a shade, leaping after a marked prey or gnawing off a share of their hunt. For animals, landscape and sheer beauty, the Serengeti National Park is the most spectacular of all Tanzanian game parks and reserves. Witness the migration of about 1.5 million animals embarking on the most trying trek from Serengeti into Maasai Mara Game Reserve in Kenya. Why not take time to sample this wildlife. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Lemala Ewanjan Tented Camp](#)) (Full Board).

Day 2. Central Serengeti / North Serengeti.

06³⁰ Hrs – (Optional) An early morning game drive will be provided before breakfast to give you more chance to explore Seronera Valley in this game park. This is the time you could spot the Lions basking in the morning sun. You could also choose to see these animals in the morning sun by flying in a hot air balloon followed by a champagne breakfast in the still dewy savannah plains.

(Note – Hot air balloon is an excursion booked separately. It is advisable that you book it early to avoid disappointment.)

07⁰⁰ Hrs - Breakfast at [Lemala Ewanjan Tented Camp](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – Depart for a full day game drive in northern Serengeti near the Tanzania and Kenya border. If you are travelling from July to October, this is the long dry season in Serengeti and the wildebeest migration is moving north to follow the thunder showers occurring in the north. July, August and September

are the months when wildebeest herds cross the crocodile-infested Mara River to reach the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. This event provides for an amazing wildlife viewing experience in Africa. Hundreds of thousands of wildebeest can congregate at crossing points, all crossing in a single continuous line of beasts while large crocodiles wait inside the water to pick off the weak and the stray ones. They usually have a feast. On the other side of the river, the lions await for the emerging beasts to get free meals. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Camp Zebra](#)). (Full Board).

Day 3 & 4. North Serengeti.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast at [Camp Zebra](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – Spend a full day in Kogatende Area. Depart for a full day game drive in Kogatende with your expert guide. Many visitors only want to see the river crossings of the more than 1.5 million wildebeests, 200,000 Burchell's zebras, 18,000 elands and about 500,000 Thomson's Gazelles filling the entire stretch of landscape. The shifting columns of the herds traverse the valleys and the hills and can only be watched in awe. There is nothing else like this on earth. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Camp Zebra](#)) (Full Board).

Day 5. North Serengeti / West Serengeti.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast at [Camp Zebra](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – You will depart from 'north' Serengeti and head south-west to Ikona Wildlife Management Area in 'west' Serengeti National Park. The great migration of wildebeests and zebras is within Tanzania for ten months. Some of the herds stay in the Serengeti all year round. The Serengeti Migration passes through Ikona Wildlife Management Area twice a year, around June-July and again when they come back in October. One game drive will be provided for in the afternoon after lunch. Other things to do here include nature walks, swimming and evening entertainment by the Simba dance troupe. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Serengeti Simba Lodge](#)) (Full Board).

Day 6. West Serengeti / Ngorongoro.

07⁰⁰ Hrs - Breakfast at [Serengeti Simba Lodge](#).

09⁰⁰ Hrs – You will check-out from Serengeti Simba Lodge and driven to Olduvai Gorge. This is the historic site know as "*The Cradle of Mankind*" where the world famous archeologist, Dr Leakey, discovered the remains of the early man. Olduvai Gorge is a canyon carved by water through the southern part of the Serengeti Plain. The gorge is about 50 km long and in some places 90 metres deep. You will then proceed to the world-famous Ngorongoro Crater at the eastern edge of the Serengeti National Park in northern Tanzania. Nearly three million years old, the ancient caldera shelters one of the most beautiful wildlife havens on earth, ringed with towering walls and sheltering forests, grasslands, fresh springs and a large soda lake. The crater is the flagship tourism feature of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The crater sinks to a depth of 610 metres, with a base area covering 260 square kilometres. Ngorongoro also has two other volcanic craters: Olmoti and Empakai famous for their stunning waterfalls and a deep lake with lush green walls. On the leeward side of the Ngorongoro highlands protrudes the iconic Oldonyo Lengai which is an active volcano that last erupted in 2007. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge](#)) (Full Board).

Day 7. Ngorongoro.

07⁰⁰ Hrs - Breakfast at [Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge](#).

07³⁰ Hrs – You will spend the day at leisure in Ngorongoro Conservation Area. You will descend into the Ngorongoro caldera very early in the morning to view the wildlife on the crater floor. The Ngorongoro Crater is often called "Africa's Eden" and the "8th Natural Wonder of the World". A massive extinct volcano, the sheet walls drop thousands of feet to a "Noah's Ark" of animals on the crater floor below. Large herds of zebra, buffalo, antelope and wildebeest graze nearby while sleeping lions laze in the sun. At dawn, the endangered black rhino returns to the thick cover of the crater forests after grazing on dew-laden grass in the morning mist. For wildlife, this area contains over 25,000 large animals including black rhinoceros, wildebeests, zebras, eland, Grant's and Thomson's gazelles. The crater has a known population of lions numbering over 60. Leopards, elephants, mountain reedbeek, buffalos, spotted hyenas, jackals and rare wild dogs are found higher up in the forests. The legendary annual wildebeest migration passes twice through Ngorongoro conservation area.

13⁰⁰ Hrs – You will have a picnic lunch on the crater floor before heading back to your base hotel to spend the afternoon at leisure. Activities to engage you in the afternoon include the spa which offers services such as massages, facials, manicures and pedicures. The spa facilities include a steam bath and a sauna. The spa is designed to meet your most discerning expectations while in Ngorongoro Conservation area. The

outdoor swimming pool offers an open air relaxed environment. Take time to enjoy hours of sunbathing pleasure. The pool area offers expansive views of the crater rim. This area is popular with cycling activities and bike hire is available onsite. You can also choose to visit the people of Ngorongoro. The most memorable human feature from the Ngorongoro Crater are the Maasai people whose Manyattas are sprinkled on its slopes. They are proud warriors that patrol the crater rim as they graze their cattle. Traditionally the Maasai live off the milk and blood of their beloved cattle and believe that all the world's cattle are theirs by God-given right. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge](#)) (Full Board).

Day 8. Ngorongoro / Lake Manyara.

07⁰⁰ Hrs - Breakfast at [Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – You will depart from Ngorongoro and head south-east to Lake Manyara National Park which is just about 1hrs drive. Our safari expert guide will take you through the wonders of the African bush. Lake Manyara provides the perfect introduction to Tanzania’s birdlife. More than 400 species have been recorded, and even a first-time visitor to Africa might reasonably expect to observe 100 of these in one day.

04⁰⁰ Hrs – A game drive will be provided after lunch to enable you discover this national park. You will be driven in 4x4 safari vehicles by highly trained drivers/tour guides. The compact game viewing circuit in Lake Manyara offers you a very memorable northern Tanzanian safari experience. From the entrance gate, the road winds through an expanse of a lush groundwater forest. Hundreds of baboon troops live in these forests and they lounge along the roadside as you pass by. Blue monkeys also live here in the ancient mahogany trees. Large buffalo, wildebeest and zebra herds congregate on the grassy plains beyond the forests as do giraffes – some so dark in coloration that they appear to be black from a distance. The legendary tree-climbing lions are found further inland within the acacia trees. Elephants and over 400 species of birds are also resident in this park. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Kirurumu Tented Lodge](#)) (Full Board).

Day 9. Lake Manyara / Tarangire.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast in your booked [Kirurumu Tented Lodge](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – Depart from Lake Manyara and head south-east to Tarangire National Park. Tarangire retains an air of undiscovered Africa, as it is less visited than other northern Tanzanian parks. It is a haven for birds. Over 550 bird species have been recorded here. Tarangire is the world’s largest selection of birds found in one habitat. Many birds found their home in Tarangire. The stocking-thigh ostrich which is the world’s largest bird might greet you in its party dress of plumes.

14⁰⁰ Hrs – A game drive will be provided after lunch to give you the opportunity to discover this national park.

20⁰⁰ Hrs – (Optional) Guests can transfer to Tarangire Safari Lodge located inside the park at an additional cost, where one can go for a night game drives to spot nocturnal animals such as aardvarks, dikdiks, genets, civet, serval cats, bush babies and various night birds. This is an optional night activity and extra fees apply. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Maramboi Tented Camp](#)) or ([Tarangire Safari Lodge](#)) (Full Board).

Day 10. Tarangire / Kilimanjaro International Airport.

07⁰⁰ Hrs - Breakfast at [Maramboi Tented Camp](#) or [Tarangire Safari Lodge](#).

09⁰⁰ Hrs – You will check-out from the lodge and driven back to Arusha to arrive in the early afternoon. Spend the afternoon in Arusha at leisure. You can go shopping for souvenirs, artefacts and Tanzanian art. Lunch is on your own account. Around (17⁰⁰-18⁰⁰Hrs) you will be transferred back to Kilimanjaro International airport in Tanzania to catch your international flight. (Breakfast only).

Seats in the tour vehicles and light air craft for your air safari shall be provided according to your booked itinerary and number of tourists in a group. Groups of **4, 5, 6** or **7** tourists travelling together may be allocated one (**1**) **tour vehicle** if they so desire. No alterations to seat arrangements will be made at the inconvenience of other parties.

Note: Please inform us for exclusive use of light aircrafts for air safaris. Exclusive light aircrafts use will be at a small additional cost.

Tour guides:

English speaking drivers/tour guides are provided. For non-English speaking tourists, any person engaged as a translator will be charged on them.

Game drives:

Most hotels provide game drives on 4x4 land cruisers/land rovers with open sides to give you a close-up maximum animal view but where the 4x4's are not available for your game drive, your tour vehicle will take on your game drive.

Prices quoted are based on 2 people sharing a double/twin room i.e. double occupancy. Single supplement applies.
