Day of Arrival - Arusha. You will be met at Kilimanjaro International airport in Tanzania and transferred to your booked hotel in Arusha. Dinner is on your own account. Stay overnight at your booked ([Hotel in Arusha](#)). (*Bed & Breakfast*)

Day 1. Arusha.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast in your booked [Hotel in Arusha](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – You will spend the whole day at leisure in Arusha in your honeymoon hideout. If you choose to explore the area, Arusha has a lot to offer. You can visit the old German boma, Uhuru monument, Arusha central market, Sakina supermarket, Njiro Complex, Sables square shopping village, Philips supermarket, Ngurdoto Museum, Ngurdoto Crater National Park and small Serengeti. A coffee tour is a three-hour guided tour that wends its way through villages. One of the local farmers will walk you through the process of growing, picking and drying the berries, before a tour of the factory where the coffee is ground and packaged as the delicious final Tanzanian product. Explore lake Duluti by canoe. It is a crater lake enclosed by plush slopes of forest. The lake offers good sites for picnics. You will have great views of Mt. Meru and Mt. Kilimanjaro at a distance. Guest can enjoy sundowners by the lake. Mountain biking will take you to the surrounding coffee plantations. It is 2 hr expedition on a bicycle that meanders through colorful village life and rural scenery zigzagging up to the hills of Mt. Meru before spiraling back. It is a good day out activity for you and your spouse. A hike on Mount Meru which is Africa’s 5th highest mountain is an exciting day out. Mountain climbers can hike Mt. Meru for fun which is less challenging compared to Mt. Kilimanjaro (*The tallest in Africa*). You can choose to visit the crater lakes of Arusha National Park which is only a short drive away. It offers the perfect day out activities for families. There is abundant wildlife to see here and park visitors can not be disappointed. Guided nature walks / bird walks will explore the surrounding forests. Good sites for guided nature and bird walks are plenty in Arusha. Dinner and overnight stay in your booked ([Hotel in Arusha](#)) (*Full Board*).

Day 2. Arusha / Tarangire.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast in your booked [Hotel in Arusha](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – Depart from Arusha and head south-west to Tarangire National Park. Tarangire retains an air of undiscovered Africa, as it is less visited than other northern Tanzanian parks. It is a haven for birds. Over 550 bird species have been recorded here. Tarangire is the world’s largest selection of birds found in one habitat. Many birds found their home in Tarangire. The stocking-thigh ostrich which is the world’s largest bird might greet you in its party dress of plumes.

14⁰⁰ Hrs – Discover this national park on a game drive through forests of enigmatic baobab and home to vast herds of buffalos and elephants or discover the inner workings of the bush on foot on an exclusive walking safari. Other activities include fly camping and bird watching.

20⁰⁰ Hrs – (Optional) Guests can transfer to Tarangire Safari Lodge located inside the park at an additional cost, where one can go for a night game drives to spot nocturnal animals such as aardvarks, dikdiks, genets, civet, serval cats, bush babies and various night birds. This is an optional night activity and extra fees apply. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Oliver's Camp](#)) or ([Tarangire Safari Lodge](#)) (Full Board).

Day 3. Tarangire.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast in [Oliver's Camp](#) or [Tarangire Safari Lodge](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – Spend the day at leisure in Tarangire. 2 game drives will be provided for, one in the morning and the other in the afternoon. Tarangire National Park is a place where elephants dot the plains like cattle, and lions roar while zebra barks fill the night. It has the second-highest concentration of wildlife of any Tanzanian national parks after Serengeti. It has reportedly the largest concentration of elephants in the world. With more than 700 resident lions sightings are common. The less visible, but nonetheless present are leopards and cheetahs. What sustain them are the large herds of zebras, wildebeest, giraffes, buffaloes and other herbivores. With more than 550 bird species, Tarangire is one of the best bird-watching destinations in Tanzania. During your game drives you will spot sun-blistered termite mounds in abundance, as well as grassy savannah plains and vast swamps. Dividing the park into two is Tarangire river with its meandering course and in some places steep riverbanks providing a dry-season lure for many wildlife encounters.

Tarangire National Park is a little quieter in terms of visitors than the Serengeti and Ngorongoro and is therefore ideal for a romantic getaway or a more peaceful family holiday. It is a perfect destination for those who would love to see many elephants, birds, giraffes and lions in the trees! It offers an authentic safari atmosphere.

20⁰⁰ Hrs – (Optional) Guests booked in Tarangire Safari Lodge which is located inside the park can go for night game drives to spot nocturnal animals such as aardvarks, dikdiks, genets, civet, serval cats, bush babies and various night birds at an additional cost. This is an optional night activity and extra fees apply. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Oliver's Camp](#)) or ([Tarangire Safari Lodge](#)) (Full Board).

Day 4. Tarangire / Ngorongoro.

07⁰⁰ Hrs - Breakfast at [Oliver's Camp](#) or [Tarangire Safari Lodge](#).

09⁰⁰ Hrs – You will check-out from Tarangire and driven north-west to Olduvai Gorge in southern Serengeti. This is the historic site know as "*The Cradle of Mankind*" where the world famous archeologist, Dr Leakey, discovered the remains of the early man. Olduvai Gorge is a canyon carved by water through the southern part of the Serengeti Plains. The gorge is about 50 km long and in some places 90 metres deep.

16⁰⁰ Hrs – You will then proceed to the world-famous Ngorongoro Crater at the eastern edge of the Serengeti National Park in northern Tanzania. Nearly three million years old, the ancient caldera shelters one of the most beautiful wildlife havens on earth, ringed with towering walls and sheltering forests, grasslands, fresh springs and a large soda lake. The crater is the flagship tourism feature of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. The crater sinks to a depth of 610 metres, with a base area covering 260 square kilometres. Ngorongoro also has two other volcanic craters: Olmoti and Empakai famous for their stunning waterfalls and a deep lake with lush green walls. On the leeward side of the Ngorongoro highlands protrudes the iconic Oldonyo Lengai which is an active volcano that last erupted in 2007. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge](#)) (Full Board).

Day 5. Ngorongoro.

07⁰⁰ Hrs - Breakfast at [Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge](#).

07³⁰ Hrs – You will spend the day at leisure in Ngorongoro Conservation Area. You will descend into the Ngorongoro caldera very early in the morning to view the wildlife on the crater floor. The Ngorongoro Crater is often called "Africa's Eden" and the "8th Natural Wonder of the World". A massive extinct volcano, the sheer walls drop thousands of feet to a "Noah's Ark" of animals on the crater floor below. Large herds of zebra, buffalo, antelope and wildebeest graze nearby while sleeping lions laze in the sun. At dawn, the endangered black rhino returns to the thick cover of the crater forests after grazing on dew-laden grass in the morning mist. For wildlife, this area contains over 25,000 large animals including black rhinoceros, wildebeests, zebras, eland, Grant's and Thomson's gazelles. The crater has a known population of lions numbering over 60. Leopards, elephants, mountain reedbeek, buffalos, spotted hyenas, jackals and rare

wild dogs are found higher up in the forests. The legendary annual wildebeest migration passes twice through Ngorongoro conservation area.

13⁰⁰ Hrs – You will have a picnic lunch on the crater floor before heading back to your base hotel to spend the afternoon at leisure. Activities to engage you in the afternoon include the spa which offers services such as massages, facials, manicures and pedicures. The spa facilities include a steam bath and a sauna. The spa is designed to meet your most discerning expectations while in Ngorongoro Conservation area. The outdoor swimming pool offers an open air relaxed environment. Take time to enjoy hours of sunbathing pleasure. The pool area offers expansive views of the crater rim. This area is popular with cycling activities and bike hire is available onsite. You can also choose to visit the people of Ngorongoro. The most memorable human feature from the Ngorongoro Crater are the Maasai people who's Manyattas are sprinkled on its slopes. They are proud warriors that patrol the crater rim as they graze their cattle. Traditionally the Maasai live off the milk and blood of their beloved cattle and believe that all the world's cattle are theirs by God-given right. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge](#)) (Full Board).

Day 6. Ngorongoro / North Serengeti.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast in [Ngorongoro Serena Safari Lodge](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – Depart from Ngorongoro and head north-west to the north area of Serengeti National Park. If you are travelling from December to April, the annual wildebeest migration in Serengeti National Park is definitely an event that you cannot afford to miss. The lush plains of the Serengeti plains have made it an ideal home to wildlife for millions of years. This ancient ecosystem continues to thrive to date and wildebeests, zebras, gazelles and giraffes are often seen grazing in herds. This is one of the best places in the world to spot lions dozing in a shade, leaping after a marked prey or gnawing off a share of their hunt. For animals, landscape and sheer beauty, the Serengeti National Park is the most spectacular of all Tanzanian game parks and reserves. Witness the migration of about 1.5 million animals embarking on the most trying trek from Serengeti into Maasai Mara Game Reserve in Kenya. Why not take time to sample this wildlife. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Camp Zebra](#)) (Full Board).

Day 7. North Serengeti.

06³⁰ Hrs – (Optional) An early morning game drive will be provided before breakfast to give you more chance to explore this game park. This is the time you could spot the Lions basking in the morning sun. You could also choose to see these animals in the morning sun by flying in a hot air balloon followed by a champagne breakfast in the still dewy savannah plains.

(Note – Hot air balloon is an excursion booked separately. It is advisable that you book it early to avoid disappointment.)

07⁰⁰ Hrs - Breakfast at [Camp Zebra](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – Spend the day at leisure in northern Serengeti near the Tanzania and Kenya border. If you are travelling from July to October, this is the long dry season in Serengeti and the wildebeest migration is moving north to follow the thunder showers occurring in the north. July, August and September are the months when wildebeest herds cross the crocodile-infested Mara River to reach the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. This event provides for an amazing wildlife viewing experience in Africa. Hundreds of thousands of wildebeest can congregate at crossing points, all crossing in a single continuous line of beasts while large crocodiles wait inside the water to pick off the weak and the stray ones. They usually have a feast. On the other side of the river, the lions await for the emerging beasts to get free meals. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Camp Zebra](#)). (Full Board).

Day 8 & 9. North Serengeti (Kogatende Area).

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast at [Camp Zebra](#).

08⁰⁰ Hrs – Spend a full day in Kogatende Area. Depart for a full day game drive in Kogatende with your expert guide. Many visitors only want to see the river crossings of the more than 1.5 million wildebeests, 200,000 Burchell's zebras, 18,000 elands and about 500,000 Thomson's Gazelles filling the entire stretch of landscape. The shifting columns of the herds traverse the valleys and the hills and can only be watched in awe. There is nothing else like this on earth. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Camp Zebra](#)) (Full Board).

Day 10. North Serengeti / Zanzibar.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast in [Camp Zebra](#).

09⁰⁰ Hrs – You will catch a 45 minutes local flight from north Serengeti and head south-east to Zanzibar island. Zanzibar is a low-lying island of coral formation with an area of about 1,650 sq km about 37 km off

the coast of Tanzania. The population is predominantly Shirazi which is a mixture of Arabs and the local population. The population in Zanzibar is approximately 1,000,000 people. Religion is mostly Islamic with small numbers of Christians and indigenous beliefs.

14⁰⁰ Hrs – You will spend the afternoon at leisure in Zanzibar. You can enjoy the beach the whole afternoon. Take a moment to read through the Zanzibar Travel Guide we will usually provide for your beach holiday activities. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Essque Zalu Zanzibar](#)) (Full Board).

Day 11 & 12. Zanzibar.

07⁰⁰ Hrs – Breakfast at [Essque Zalu Zanzibar](#).

09⁰⁰ Hrs – Your tour guide will take a full day to show you Zanzibar including the surrounding Islands of the Archipelago. You can also choose to stay-in to enjoy the white sandy beaches and the ocean activities. On the western side of the island is the main settlement area best-known part of which is Stone Town. To the east of Stone Town is the growing section of Ng'ambo area and to the north of the town are a number of pristine beaches. At the northern tip of the island is the dhow-building centre and tourist resort of Nungwi beach. Some of Zanzibar's best beaches are found along the eastern shores of the island. The Zanzibar archipelago also includes the neighbouring island of Pemba and numerous smaller off shore islands that include Changuu also called prison island, Bawi, Cahwani also called grave island, Tumbatu, Mnemba, Chumbe and the sandbanks of Nyange, Pange and Murogo. Places to discover in Zanzibar include: spice tours, history of stone town with an exotic mix of sultan's palaces, Portuguese forts and ancient dhow harbors, old slave market, the house of wonders, the old dispensary and the home of arch slaver 'tipu-tip'. Cultural sites in and around stone town include: Livingstone house, Hamamni baths, national museum, Chukwani palace, Jozani forest - the last red Columbus monkey sanctuary, Mtoni palace ruins, Maruhubi palace ruins, Persian baths of Kidichi and Mangapwani slave caves. Beach and ocean activities to engage you include diving, snorkeling and traditional sailing. What the archipelago does have, however, is astonishing marine life, with dolphins and multi-coloured sea creatures. There is also a healthy population of endangered red colombus monkeys and giant Aldabra tortoises. Your tour guide will take through land and sea, with snorkelling trips to the magnificent coral reefs of uninhabited Chumbe Island and walks through two forest reserves; one primate-laden and the other home to rare antelopes. There is also a trip to Prison Island, where land tortoises creep along the beach, and a stop to watch bottlenose and humpback dolphins frolicking in the waves.

Stone Town: Doors in the island capital of Stone Town still boast brass studs for repelling war elephants by merchants who sought to protect themselves from "combat" elephants that were historically deployed in India and Persia. However large mammals no longer dwell on the Spice Island. Dinner and overnight stay at ([Essque Zalu Zanzibar](#)) (Full Board).

Day 13. Zanzibar / Zanzibar International Airport.

07⁰⁰ Hrs - Breakfast at [Essque Zalu Zanzibar](#).

09⁰⁰ Hrs - You will spend the day at leisure in your booked beach hotel. You can go shopping for souvenirs, artifacts and Tanzanian art in Stone Town, Zanzibar. Lunch is on your own account.

17⁰⁰-18⁰⁰Hrs - You will be transferred to Zanzibar International airport to catch your international flight or catch your local light aircraft flight to Dar es Salaam for your onward international connection. (Breakfast only).
